## Crochet Headband with Flower

## Supplies:

Worsted Weight yarn H hook (5.0) 3/4 inch button Yarn Needle

#### Abbreviations:

sc: single Crochet dc: double crochet

sts: stitches ch: chain

2sctog=2 single crochet together



Measures 23 inches long to fit an adult 23-24 inch head. If you want it shorter decrease the number of middle rows.

### Instructions:

H hook

# Buttonhole End (5 ½ inches)

Row 1: chain 6

Row 2: sc in 2nd chain from the hook, sc in next 4, ch 1, turn (5 sts.)

Row 3: sc in each stitch across, ch 1, turn (5 sts.)

Row 4: sc in first 2, ch2, skip next stitch, sc in last 2, ch 1, turn, (5sts.)

Rows 5-9 (5 rows): sc in each stitch across, ch 1, turn (5 sts.)

Row 10: 2 sc in first st, 1 sc in next 3, 2 sc in last, ch1, turn (7 sts.)

Rows 11-15 (5 rows): sc in each stitch across, ch 1, turn (7 sts.)

Row 16: 2 sc in first st, 1 sc in next 5, 2 sc in last, ch1, turn (9 sts.)

Rows 17-21 (5 rows): sc in each stitch across, ch 1, turn (9 sts.)

Row 22: 2 sc in first st, 1 sc in next 7, 2 sc in last, ch 1, turn (11 sts.)

## Middle Section (13 inches)

Rows 23-77: sc in each stitch across, ch 1, turn (11 sts.) until headband measures 18 1/2" (decrease number of rows in the middle section to make a shorter band)

#### Button End (4 ½ iches)

Row 78: join first 2 st.(2sctog), 1 sc in next 7, join last 2 st (2sctog)., ch 1, turn (9 sts.)

Rows 79-83 (5 rows): sc in each stitch across., ch 1, turn (9 sts.)

Row 84: join first 2 st (2sctog), 1 sc in next 5, join last 2 st (2sctog), ch 1, turn (7 sts.)

Rows 85-89 (5 rows): sc in each stitch across, ch 1, turn (7 st.)

Row 90: join first 2 st (2sctog), 1 sc in next 3, join last 2 st (2sctog), ch 1 turn (5 sts.)

Rows 91-95 (5 rows): sc in each stitch across, ch 1, turn (5 sts.)

Sew a 3/4 in. button on with yarn in desired location.



# Crochet Flower/Rosette

Supplies: Worsted Weight yarn H hook (5.0)

Start:

ch 36 (leave a long starting tail for anchoring Rosette)

Row 1: dc in 5th ch from hook,

\*ch 1, skip 1sc, (dc-ch1-dc) in next sc (one v-stitch made) repeat from \* across: (16 V-stitches made), turn.

Row 2: ch 3- counts as dc, 5 dc first ch-space,

\*sc in next ch-1 space, 6 dc in next ch-1 space- one shell stitch made repeat from\* across ending 6 dc in last ch-1 space- (16 shell stitches total) fasten off, leaving long tail for anchoring Rosette.

Starting at this end, roll first shell tightly to form center bud Roll remaining strip to form Rosette.

Secure by stitching in and out through layers of foundation to form Rosette.

Secure onto the headband with yarn
